HOMEWORK TASKS

SPELLING- This will start later in Term 1

READING - 5 X a week for 20 minutes minimum. Home reading book brought to school every day. The book, what page they are up to, should be recorded in their diary, daily.

MATHS –Activities relevant to each week’s topic to be completed and pasted in the homework book.

Parent/guardian signature required each week.

DIARIES – This is the student’s organisational tool. It needs to go home each night and referred to. Diaries are handed in every Wednesday and checked by the teacher. We check for

- Parent/guardian signature

STUDY GROUP will be on Wednesday's between 3.05 and 4pm and requires a permission note for attendance.

ASSESSMENT

The students will be assessed against their year level 'I can' statements and will be aiming for Proficient or above.

COMPASS:

The teachers will be using COMPASS for a range of reasons throughout the year:
